Help us shape the new Medical School at Bielefeld University: interprofessional, future-oriented, diverse and strong in research and teaching

The Medical School OWL of Bielefeld University and the Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel (EvKB) intend to fill at the Campus Bielefeld-Bethel an indefinite

Professorship for Interdisciplinary Intensive Care Medicine (W2 or W2 TT W2)

at the earliest possible date as senior physician in the University Department of Anesthesiology, Intensive Care, Emergency Medicine, Transfusion Medicine and Pain Therapy.

At Bielefeld University, an innovative faculty of human medicine with an interdisciplinary individual and population medicine orientation and the University Hospital OWL (UK OWL), with the Klinikum Bielefeld, Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel (EvKB), and Klinikum Lippe as holders, is established. Teaching is scheduled to begin in the winter semester of 2021/22. We are looking for personalities who want to seize the development situation and its challenges as an opportunity and actively participate in research, teaching, patient care, and organization. We offer an exciting environment that opens up a wide range of opportunities. You will be significantly involved in the further planning and implementation of the model study program in human medicine (according to ÄApprO), as well as in implementing the "clinician" and "advanced clinician scientist" programs, and will have the opportunity to apply innovative concepts in teaching and medical education. At the same time, you will play a decisive role in establishing a nationally and internationally competitive research profile "Medicine for people with disabilities and chronic diseases". The establishment of a corresponding research profile capable of being collaboratively researched is a declared goal of the location. The call is addressed to personalities with a promising nationally and internationally visible research profile (W2) respectively to those who are in an early career stage with an already promising research profile (W2 TT W2) who can both represent the field in research, teaching, and patient care in its entirety.

The prerequisites are:

- Many years (for W2) or broad (for W2 TT W2) clinical experience
- clinical leadership and management skills as well as team orientation
- very good (for W2) or promising (for W2 TT W2) scientific achievements, which are reflected by appropriate publications and third-party funding
- connectivity to the medical research profile
- relevant teaching experience for the subject to be represented
- experience and commitment in the promotion of young scientists
- completed specialist training in anesthesiology as well as the additional qualifications in intensive care medicine and emergency medicine
- doctorate in human medicine and additional scientific achievements according to § 36 para.
 1; no. 4 HG NRW

Qualification as an "antibiotic stewardship" expert, experience with extracorporeal cardiac and pulmonary support systems, as well as active work in professional societies and the development of own research interests are also expected.

We expect networking with other UK OWL holders, especially within the inter-agency organized specialist hospital network for anesthesiology, other faculties of Bielefeld University, and with the medical community in private practice in the region. Accordingly, we are looking for a leader with proven leadership experience and expertise in the entire field, and excellent communication and coordination skills.

The intensive care unit of the anesthesiology university department at EvKB comprises two intensive care units (surgical and interdisciplinary) and one IMC unit with a total of 51 beds under anesthesiological management. The intensive care spectrum covers all surgical patients of the hospital (including supraregional trauma center, neurosurgery, thoracic surgery, general and visceral surgery, vascular surgery). Further focal points are the care of neurological patients within the framework of the neurovascular network as well as internal patients, in particular from oncology, nephrology and gastroenterology in the interdisciplinary intensive care unit. In addition, the shock rooms and the resuscitation teams are supervised by the intensive care team.

Clinical research is to be organized and implemented across disciplines and hospitals as part of a structural and development concept for the entire faculty that is being created with your participation. Competitive laboratory infrastructure and central animal husbandry will be provided. In addition, there are opportunities for cooperation with 13 neighboring faculties as well as with the Center for Biotechnology.

The EvKB guarantees that the holder of the professorship will be released from health care duties to an appropriate extent and can conduct independent research.

The Bielefeld-Bethel Campus would like to encourage female candidates in particular to apply for this position. Through a family-conscious personnel policy, EvKB promotes a sustainable balance between personal lifestyle and career. Competent support is provided in arranging childcare places.

For the appeal:

The W2 professorship for Interdisciplinary Intensive Care Medicine is to be filled for an indefinite period and belongs to the specialist hospital network of the UK OWL in anesthesiology. The duties within the scope of patient care are regulated by a service-employment contract with the Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel.

The W2-tenure-track position is initially limited to five years, but with a tenure-track option after W2. In the case of a positive evaluation, the term of office will be terminated within the framework of the tenure-track procedure of Bielefeld University on the basis of a target agreement. In exceptional cases, the term of office may be terminated earlier.

The teaching load of the Clinical Professorships is 4 LVS according to § 5 para. 3 LVV from the beginning of the study program. The hiring requirements are based on § 36 HG.

Applications from suitable severely disabled persons and persons with disabilities of equal status are expressly encouraged. Bielefeld University has received several awards for its success in equal opportunities and is certified as a family-friendly university. Among other things, the University pursues a committed equal opportunities policy concerning the appointment of professorships and would expressly like to invite qualified female applicants to apply. Applications are treated in accordance with the State Equality Act. Family times are considered in the context of the selection decision.

The Faculty considers equality between women and men to be an important task, and the future jobholder will be involved in its implementation.

Bielefeld University promotes dual-career couples and supports them with a range of services to help them create a common place of work and life.

In addition to the usual application documents and information, we ask you to submit each a 2-page teaching and research concept paper, as well as a concept for patient care and interdisciplinary cooperation. These concept papers should integrate gender- and diversity-specific

content relevant to the advertised professorship. We expect a brief description of your planned gender equality activities, besides, particularly for the promotion of young female scientists and the compatibility of career and family.
